Measurements

1. Measure the width of the closet in 3 places to account for unevenness of the wall. Provide the shortest measurement when ordering or requesting more information. Do not include the baseboard molding in the measurement if it is a wall system. Deductions will be made from your measurements to fit the unit in.
2. Units are 14" deep and hung at 84" high (to accommodate a 96" high ceiling)
3. Reach in closets need to be 22" deep to accommodate hanging clothes
